The parish has a treat in store for all of us. We are bringing out Susan Conroy. Who is she? Susan is known for hosting a 13 part series called "Speaking of Saints" on EWTN. She has been working on a new series filmed in her home state, Maine, entitled "Coming to Christ."

Susan is making a CCW Deanery tour in Wyoming but we managed to get her to come to St. John's to talk about her eleven year relationship with St. Teresa of Calcutta and the role of mercy.

Susan will give a talk on St. Teresa of Calcutta and Divine Mercy on Saturday, April 15, 3:00 p.m. open to EVERYONE.....NON-CATHOLICS, MEN AND WOMEN, CHILDREN, TEENAGERS AND SENIOR CITIZENS. Susan will attend the 5:00 p.m. Mass and then join us for a Pot Luck Dinner afterwards. Again, all are invited

to attend. You can get a chance to visit with her. Her books will also be available.

This is a very rare opportunity for us to get to know Saint Teresa of Calcutta through a person who knew her well.

Living and Giving in Christ: Unity through Diocesan Ministries begins this weekend. We ask for your prayerful consideration:

-if you have supported these ministries in the past with a gift, we thank you and ask that you give again this year;

-if you have not supported these ministries in the past, please prayerfully consider doing so this year.

Pope Francis says that "God asks everything of us, yet at the same time He offers everything to us." (Joy of the Gospel, Paragraph 12).

Please take time to review the materials you have received in the mail. Next weekend we will ask for your commitment in supporting the ministries of the local Church; the Diocese of Cheyenne.

The goals for our parish and the missions are:

St. John's.....\$53,036 (up 2.4% from last year's goal of \$51,778)

St. Mary's..... \$1,407 (down 4.6% from last year's goal of \$1,475)

St. Hubert's.... \$990 (up 28.2% from last year's goal of \$772)

Since St. John's and St. Mary's did not make their goals the parish had to take \$21,000 out of savings to pay off our obligations. Ouch....that hurt. I would have preferred to put that money away in savings or investments for the future of our parish.

Parish goals are *not* arbitrarily set up by the Diocese. The goals are, in essence, taxes of 20% of gross income from collections plus 10% of interest investment, rental and royalty income.

What people do not give toward the goals is billed to the parish. The better a parish does, the more it is expected to contribute to the Diocese, or as it is officially phrased; "the Diocese shares in your successes and your challenges."

OK.....here they are.....all the clergy assignments in the Diocese. All moves are to take place by 12:00 o'clock noon on July 6 unless otherwise noted.

Fr. James Heiser of Sheridan will become pastor of Jackson.

Fr. Glen Whewell of Powell will become pastor of Sheridan.

Fr. Philip Wagner of St. Stephen's Mission will become pastor of Powell

Fr. Hugo Blotsky will retire and become chaplain at the Wyoming Catholic College.

Fr. Lucas Simango of St. Anthony's in Casper will become pastor of Jackson.

Fr. Killian Muli of Newcastle is being released from the Diocese to serve as a U.S. Army Chaplain for the Archdiocese for the Military Services effective May 26.

Fr. Tim Martinson of Evanston will become pastor of Newcastle.

Fr. Kevin Barrett, a priest from outside the Diocese, will be Parochial Administrator of St. Anthony's in Casper.

Fr. Jesryll Intes, Parochial Administrator of Pinedale will be Parochial Administrator of Evanston.

Fr. Louis Shea, Parochial Vicar (aka "associate pastor") of Jackson will be the Parochial Administrator of Lovell and Greybull.

Fr. Robert Rodgers will be Parochial Vicar in Sheridan.

Fr. Brian Hess, Parochial Vicar in Sheridan, will be Parochial Vicar in Jackson.

Deacon Andrew Kinstetter, upon ordination to the priesthood on May 20, will be Parochial Vicar at St. Stephen's.

Fr. Peter Johnson of Buffalo.....well.... looks like you're stuck with me! I have a letter that allows me to stay until 2019.

Update on the Church in Kaycee. The current owners of the building and land that are used by the congregation in Kaycee have been very gracious and understanding of this highly unusual arrangement made decades ago where the Church can use the building and land for as long as there are Church services. The owners have given permission for us to replace the roof, paint the Church and the trim and repair the indoor plumbing. I am waiting for some necessary documentation from the roofer before signing the contract. The roof will cost \$8,700.

Update on St. John's Church roof project. We have completed all the necessary paper work, paid half of the cost and are waiting for work to begin in early June. The cost will be \$52,000.

Coffee and donuts are back! You know Lent is officially over not because we have Easter, but when we get donuts back! Please come after the Sunday Masses to enjoy a time of fellowship.

A request please. As the tourist season is about to begin, please consider stepping outside your comfort zone and ask someone you don't know if they are visiting. If so, invite them to come over to the hall and join you for

coffee and a donut. Last year we had a great response from our visitors and we met people from Ireland, Sweden, France and Spain as well as people from all over our nation.

Vacation Bible School (VBS) is coming to St. John's on Monday, June 13 to Friday, June 17! We are starting to put out registration forms at the entrances of the Church. Any child entering Pre-K thru 6th grade this September may be enrolled in VBS.

There are no fees, though we have a "wish list" of things we hope people would consider donating. The parish is absorbing the costs of materials.

We ask that you pre-register your children as soon as possible so we can make sure to have all the supplies that are needed for a fun time of learning.
