William J. Dendiger, Bishop Emeritus from Grand Island, Nebraska. Reception to follow in Hartmann Hall. You are also invited to attend a Holy Hour on Thursday, May 18 at 7:00 p.m. in the Cathedral.

The following message was sent to the clergy by the Chancellor, Ms. Carol DeLois: *"The Diocese of Cheyenne recently placed a bid on the old police department building located one-half block from the Chancery Office. This was an opportunity to buy property close to the Cathedral. Our current location is not large enough to accommodate the offices and ministries provided by the Diocese of Cheyenne. We have been informed that we placed the only bid for this property, and there are several steps that need to be taken before the process is completed by the City Council on May 22. Further information will be forthcoming."*

Mr. Victor Hannuneh of Bethlehem is returning to Buffalo for the weekend of May 13 and 14! The tragic violence in the Middle East and the highly restrictive policies imposed by the government of Israel on Palestinians have created severe economic instability for Arab Palestinian Christians who live in the area of Bethlehem, a name which means "House of Bread."

In the neighboring village of Beit-Sahour, from where the shepherds most likely came to be the first people to worship the Christ Child, Palestinian Christian families have carved exquisite olive wood religious works for generations. Current travel restrictions imposed by Israel on Palestine have dramatically reduced both pilgrimages and tourism. The livelihood of these Christian families is severely threatened.

Victor is part of a group of Palestinian Christians traveling around our country selling these superb carvings. The revenue generated

helps to restore justice to an oppressed Palestinian Christian minority, supports over 300 families of skilled carvers and helps in keeping a Christian presence in the Holy Land.

Victor will display the carvings after the Saturday evening Mass on May 13 and the Sunday morning Masses on May 14. Your purchase, however small or big, will be an act of social justice as well as provide an opportunity to own or give as gifts original folk art from Bethlehem.

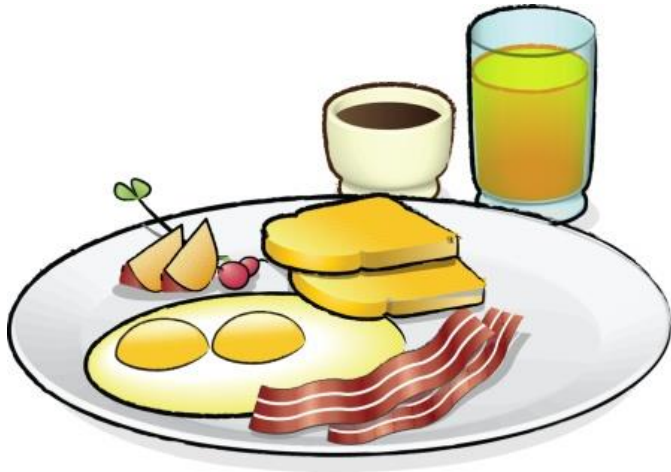
