**FROM FR. PETE:**

The following people and their companies did some excellent work for our parish this summer for which I am very grateful. Please consider using them for your home or business projects.

**S.G. Welsh Co. Inc.** 307-684-2673.

Shawn Welsh, owner. Shawn and his crew removed the stone retaining walls by the west side of the Church and all the dying bushes in front of the rectory. He helped Phil Gonzalez to determine the necessary grade for the "quad" so that rain and snow melt would flow away from the Church. He then removed the grass on the quad and pulled out the tree stump in the front of the Church. He did this at very little cost to the parish, saving us quite a bit of money.

**Tree Mechanics.** 307-217-2899. Garrett Dotson, owner. This was the outfit that so expertly fell the large spruce to make way for what is not the decorative "patio" in the front of the Church. Garrett has also offered a very reasonable rate to the parish to fertilize all existing spruce and pine trees on Church property and to cut down the three trees near the shrine on the north side of the Church.

**Romine Construction Inc.** Mike Romine, owner. Mike and his crew did a phenomenal job preparing for the new

sidewalks along the west side of the Church. Mike created the ramps on Lobban and Snider to make it easier for those in wheel chairs or walkers. Mike and his son-in-law created the artistic herring bone pattern on what is not called the "patio."

**Rock Creek Roofing, LLC.** 307-620-0862. Kyle Cummings, owner. This company did a superb job removing the old roof on the Church and placing the new one on. Their work was meticulous.

**Powder River Seamless Rain Gutters.** 307-620-6053. Josh Chapman, owner. This company replaced and in some cases added rain gutters to the Church to help improve drainage away from the Church.

**Landscaping Services Inc.** 307-673-4360. Bill Arno, owner. Bill and his crew did all the landscaping around the Church, in front of the Church, the front of the rectory and installed sod in the "quad" by the west side of the Church.

This company installed the pillar lighting around the quad, the new lighting along the buttresses on the west side of the Church and upgraded the pillar lighting in the front of the Church. There were no costs to the parish for material or

labor, saving us a significant amount of money.
